

# Burkina Faso solar battery power

How will a solar power plant help Burkina Faso?

The Donsin Airport solar power plant will be equipped with a battery electricity storage system. Burkina Faso's transitional parliament approved a \$49 million loan from the Export-Import Bank of China (CHEXIM) that will help one of the world's least electrified countries marginally increase its electricity generation.

How much solar power does Burkina Faso have?

Burkina Faso had just 62 MW of installed PV at the end of 2020. The World Bank has agreed to support Burkina Faso's Sustainable Renewables Risk Mitigation Initiative (SRMI) to improve access to electricity in rural areas with \$168 million.

Is Burkina Faso suitable for solar PV and wind development?

The study combines high-quality resource data with supplementary factors (i.e. protected areas, topography, transmission lines and road network proximity) using a suitability assessment approach. The findings of this study indicate that a significant portion of Burkina Faso's land area is suitable for solar PV and wind development.

Will Burkina Faso invest \$400 million in solar?

"This new scheme will enable Burkina Faso to mobilize more than \$400 million in private investment in solar production and innovative battery storage systems," added Alexis Madelain, project team leader at the World Bank.

Can Burkina Faso achieve 95% electricity access?

The country aims to reach 95% electricity access, with 50% in rural areas and universal access to clean cooking solutions in urban areas, with 65% in rural areas by 2030, up from 9% in 2020. The utilisation of Burkina Faso's renewable resource potential would enable the country to reduce its heavy reliance on thermal generation and energy imports.

Will a 50 MWp solar power plant bolster Burkina Faso's electricity supply strategy?

In a pivotal move to bolster Burkina Faso's electricity supply strategy, the Minister of Energy, Mines, and Quarries, Simon-Pierre BOUSSIM, and Serge CONSEIGA, General Director of Energie Plus, sealed an agreement for the construction of a 50-megawatt peak (50 MWp) solar power plant in the commune of Komsilga, Burkina Faso.

Burkina Faso's transitional parliament has approved a conventional loan agreement worth EUR45.7 million from the Export-Import Bank of China. The debt will finance the construction of the Donsin solar power plant and its electricity storage system.

The main objective of this paper was to investigate the performance enhancement of the PV/diesel power plant in the Bilgo village in Burkina Faso.
