Who designed the Sun & Sea organ monument in Croatia?

The monument to the Sun and the Sea organ were both designed by Croatian architect Nikola Bašić. The monument is located at the entrance to the port of the Croatian town of Zadar on the western point of the Zadar peninsula.

It compliments nature via light and the other attraction close by, the Sea organ which communicates nature via sound.

Where are the Solar System planets displayed on the Riva?

The Solar System planets are displayed on the Riva of Zadar. On the chrome ring that surrounds the photo-voltage solar modules on the Sun monument, are inscribed the names of Zadar's saints.
