How many people need emergency assistance in the Democratic Republic of the Congo?

Nearly 5.8 million people need emergency assistance as a result of conflict in the Democratic Republic of the Congo. The humanitarian situation continues to deteriorate in the eastern portion of the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC).

What is happening in the Democratic Republic of the Congo?

The humanitarian situation continues to deteriorate in the eastern portion of the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC). In January 2023 alone, more than 200 civilians were killed in Ituri Province in a series of attacks by non-state armed groups, which also destroyed 2,000 houses and closed or demolished 80 schools.

Does UNHCR still provide emergency assistance in the DRC?

The delivery of emergency assistance continues despite severe underfunding in the DRC. By the end of 2023, UNHCR's US\$233 million plan to assist both internally displaced people and refugees in the DRC was only 43 per cent funded.

What are the priority needs in the DRC?

Other priority needs among crisis-affected populations in the DRC include health, protection, and WASH assistance, with the HRP designating more than \$1 billion for food assistance and nearly \$266 million in funding to meet health and WASH needs.

What are the conditions for displaced people in the DRC?

Conditions for displaced people in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) are worsening on a daily basis as resources run dry, and many find themselves unable to satisfy their most urgent needs without humanitarian assistance. People are internally displaced across the DRC, refugees and asylum-seekers in the DRC.

How many people are internally displaced in the DRC?
