From Guam, USDA has received 2 applications for REAP, representing a total funding request of \$177,853--all have been awarded. Powering Affordable Clean Energy Program (PACE): In May, USDA made \$1 billion available under PACE to fund new clean energy projects and energy storage in rural America though partially forgivable loans.
