What is the Heard Island & McDonald Islands Marine Reserve management plan?

The Heard Island and McDonald Islands Marine Reserve Management Plan 2014-2024 is due for its 10-year statutory review. This review is being undertaken by the Australian Antarctic Division, a Division of the Department of Climate Change, Energy, the Environment and Water. We are inviting members of the public to provide comments on a:

When is public consultation on the Heard Island & McDonald Islands Marine Reserve open?

Public consultation on the proposal to expand the Heard Island and McDonald Islands Marine Reserve and proposal to prepare a draft management plan for the reserve was open from 5 July 2024 to 5 September 2024. The public comment period has now closed.

Why should the Heard Island & McDonald Islands Marine Reserve be expanded?

The proposed expansion of the Heard Island and McDonald Islands Marine Reserve would protect unique marine and terrestrial areas of high conservation value. The islands and surrounding marine environment provide important habitat for many species and encompass a range of geomorphic features.

Where are Heard Island and McDonald Islands located?

The islands are a territory (Territory of Heard Island and McDonald Islands) of Australia administered from Hobart by the Australian Antarctic Division of the Australian Department of Climate Change, Energy, the Environment and Water.

How big is Heard Island & McDonald Islands?

The group's overall land area is 372 km² (144 sq mi) and it has 101.9 km (63.3 mi) of coastline. Discovered in the mid-19th century, the islands lie on the Kerguelen Plateau in the Indian Ocean and have been an Australian territory since 1947. Heard Island and McDonald Islands contain Australia's only two active volcanoes.

Does Heard Island have a harbour?

Heard Island and the McDonald Islands have no ports or harbours; ships must anchor offshore. The coastline is 101.9 km (63.3 mi) in extent, and a 12 nmi (22 km) territorial sea and 200 nmi (370 km) exclusive fishing zone are claimed. [2]
