



How much gas can a gas storage station store

This is the first real comment. I too haul gas in Los Angeles. 8800 gallons of gas per delivery. A busy gas station needs about 1 delivery a day. Costcos need 6 - 12 deliveries a day. Most gas stations have 3 underground tanks. 87, 91 and diesel, each tank holds 10k to 12k gallons. Costco's have 3, 30k tanks.
