

What does Kuwait authority for partnership projects do?

Kuwait Authority for Partnership Projects is tasked with negotiating power purchase agreements for independent water and power producers, and it negotiated the first such project in Kuwait, Az Zour North power station, on behalf of the government.

How does Kuwait power plant work?

Kuwait Ministry of Electricity and Water (MEW) delivers natural gas for the power plant through a 40in pipeline constructed by Kuwait Oil Company (KOC), while the gas oil is delivered through a new 16in branched pipeline. The electricity generated by the power plant is fed to the national grid through a connection to 400kV substation at Az-Zour.

How can Kuwait keep pace with rising demand for electricity?

Keeping pace with rising demand for electricity will be critical to Kuwait's economic development, and reforms, such as opening up the power generation sector to independent power producers and independent water and power producers, are key to increasing the currently low share of private company involvement in the sector.

What is the future of Kuwait's Electricity sector?

The Ministry of Electricity and Water estimates that reserve margins could drop to 8% by 2020. Kuwait plans to increase base-load electricity generating capacity to 32 GW by 2035 (see Chapter 2). Until very recently, the Ministry of Electricity and Water was solely responsible for the development of the electricity sector.

Which government institutions are involved in the power sector in Kuwait?

Kuwait has several government institutions participating at varying levels in the power sector, all with different mandates. The Ministry of Electricity and Water oversees all aspects of generation, transmission and distribution of electricity.

How many power plants are there in Kuwait?

Source: Al-Sayed and Assem (2003). In 2018, Kuwait had an installed electric generation capacity of 18.8 gigawatts (GW), with nine power plants. Steam generation accounted for nearly half of total capacity, with combined-cycle steam and gas plants making up another 40%. Open-cycle gas-fired generation accounted for some 8% in 2018.
