Why did the General Assembly vote on Israel's occupation of Palestine?

The General Assembly passed a resolution demanding an end to Israel's occupation of Palestine within the next twelve months by an overwhelming margin on Wednesday. The vote came in the middle of its 10th emergency special session considering Israeli actions in occupied East Jerusalem and the rest of the Occupied Palestinian Territory.

Will Palestine become a UN observer state?

During its resumed tenth emergency special session, the General Assembly adopted a resolution that -- as of 10 September 2024 -- upgrades Palestine's rights at the United Nations as an observer State, urging the Security Council to favourably consider its full membership.

How are Palestinians governed?

The various ways that Palestinians are governed lack coherence. Many are citizens of Israel, a state that identifies itself as belonging to the Jewish people as a nation. Others are governed by that state but are not citizens of it. For such Palestinians, almost all aspects of movement and security operate under palpable Israeli control.

Are Palestinians stateless?

Palestinians are not stateless, but Palestine is. That is, there is no Palestine that can claim sovereignty, but Palestinians are very much subject to a host of states and state-like structures. The various ways that Palestinians are governed lack coherence.

Can a two-state solution bring peace in the Middle East?

The only viable path towards a just, comprehensive and lasting peace in the Middle East is through the two-State solution -- with Israel and Palestine living side by side in peace and security, in line with international law, the Charter of the United Nations and relevant UN resolutions.

Why did Saudi Arabia oppose the UN resolution granting Palestine full membership?

The representative of Saudi Arabia, associating himself with the Non-Aligned Movement, OIC and the Arab Group, deplored that the Council was unable to adopt the resolution granting Palestine full UN membership and underscored that "the world can no longer ignore the suffering of the Palestinian people".
