

Saudi Arabia government solar system scheme

What are Saudi Arabia's new solar PV rules?

The Electricity and Cogeneration Regulatory Authority (ECRA) of Saudi Arabia has released new rules for distributed solar PV systems ranging from 1 kW to 2 MW for all kinds of energy consumers, in order to encourage electricity consumers to install PV systems under the national net metering scheme.

What is a solar metering regulation in Saudi Arabia?

These regulations aim to promote the connection of small-scale solar PV systems to the distribution system, establish a net metering scheme, as well as ensure efficient and safe construction, installation, maintenance and operation of these PV systems within Saudi Arabia.

What are the major solar projects in Saudi Arabia?

Key projects include the King Abdullah Petroleum Studies and Research Center's solar endeavor and Saudi Aramco's PV carport system. In addition, ACWA Power has recently completed the Al Shuaibah solar projects, which are expected to supply approximately 2.6 GW of solar electricity to the country.

Are solar rooftops available in Saudi Arabia?

Solar rooftops are relatively scarce in the kingdom. Saudi Arabia's Electricity & Cogeneration Regulatory Authority has published new rules for distributed-generation solar installations which it is anticipated will encourage electricity consumers to install PV systems under the country's net billing regime.

Does Saudi Arabia have solar power?

Saudi officials have talked about solar power for years, and even made plans to install 41,000 MW over the next 20 years, but whilst China installed 5,000 MW in 2012 alone, Saudi Arabia still has virtually no solar generation capacity. Will Saudi Arabia introduce net metering for small scale solar?

Saudi Arabia made a first attempt to introduce net metering for small scale solar in August 2017, but a draft regulation prepared at the time was never adopted. The kingdom had 334 MW of solar generation capacity at the end of last year, according to the International Renewable Energy Agency.

Under the new scheme, named for the Arabic word for renewables *Mutjaded*, component manufacturers can borrow up to 75% of a project's cost from the government and benefit from loan repayment ...
