Deep discharge reduces the battery's cycle life, as shown in Fig. 1. Also, overcharging can cause unstable conditions. To increase battery cycle life, battery manufacturers recommend operating in the reliable SOC range and charging frequently as battery capacity decreases, rather than charging from a fully discharged SOC or maintaining a high ...

Battery life expectancy is mostly driven by usage cycles. As demonstrated by the LG and Tesla product warranties, thresholds of 60% or 70% capacity are warranted through a certain number of charge cycles.

Ahmadi et al. (2014) assume that after losing 20% of its rated capacity, a second life battery can be reused for energy storage until it loses a further 15% of its capacity. Based on a parameterized life cycle model, they argue that a 56% reduction in CO2 emissions is possible if one substitutes the natural gas generation for peak generation ...
