How long does solar energy last in South Sudan?

Most of Sudan's electricity generation comes from hydropower, and more than half of the Eastern African region's total oil-based capacity is located in the country. Solar energy currently makes up less than 0.1% of Sudan's energy supply; but there is immense potential because there is an average of 8.5 to 11 hours of sunshine per day [Citation 46]. Figure 6 compares solar energy generation in Sudan and other African countries from 2015 to 2019, and shows that Sudan is not capitalising on its potential.
