What is Telecommunications in Sudan?

Telecommunications in Sudan includes fixed and mobile telephones, the Internet, radio, and television. Approximately 12 million out of 45 million people in Sudan use the Internet, mainly on smartphones and mobile computers. Sudan had telecommunication services as early as 1897.

How does FEI finance Tesco in South Sudan?

CREI secures \$20 million from FEI to finance TESCO in South Sudan for "energy as a service" telecom project. Finnfund provides \$5 million mezzanine loan to support the development of 413 hybrid power solutions for telecom sites in South Sudan.

How many people use the Internet in South Sudan?

According to reports, there were 1.36 million internet users in South Sudan in January 2024, with an internet penetration rate of 12.1% at that time. The project will significantly boost solar power production, benefiting over 2 million people by enhancing the reliability of mobile connections.
