



# Startup renewable energy companies Lesotho

A prototype of the system has been installed at a small clinic in Lesotho; next year, the MIT team plans to have five fully operational systems installed in isolated clinics and schools there for field-testing.

Launched in 2023, Renewable Lesotho is part of the Global Gateway, Europe's strategy to boost smart, clean and secure connections in digital, energy and transport sectors, and to strengthen health, education and research systems across the world.

Founded in 2015, OnePower is a fast-growing start-up whose primary goal is to attract investment to the renewable energy sector in Lesotho to make energy access projects a reality for these communities.

The project will support 12 women entrepreneurs to create energy-enabled businesses in three communities, serving a population of more than 5,000 people. The project also aims to distribute over 450 energy efficient appliances and ...

Energy demand is growing in South Africa and the rest of the region, and Lesotho has the potential to export renewable power. Opportunities exist for U.S. companies to supply renewable energy products or to develop renewable power generation in Lesotho.

The Renewable Energy Performance Platform (REPP) will fund the solar project. Scatec, Norwegian investment fund Norfund, startup One Power Lesotho, Izuba Energy and the Lesotho Pension Fund will act as equity co-sponsors.
