

Who financed so Tome & Principe solar power plant?

The project is financed by the African Development Bank (AfDB). A solar power plant will soon be built in São Tomé and Principe. The government of this Central African island country has chosen to build the plant south of Santo Amaro, a town located in the north of the island of São Tomé.

Does Sao Tome & Principe have solar power?

According to data from the International Renewable Energy Agency (IRENA), Sao Tome and Principe did not have any grid-connected solar generation capacity installed at the end of 2021. The World Bank says Sao Tome and Principe has an electricity access rate of around 76%, with 92% of the total coming from imported diesel.

Will so Tomé and Principe build a solar power plant?

The government of São Tomé and Príncipe is launching a tender for the construction of a 1.5 MWp solar photovoltaic plant south of Santo Amaro. The project is financed by the African Development Bank (AfDB). A solar power plant will soon be built in São Tomé and Principe.

Is EMAE dragging down the economy of so Tomé & Principe?

The troubles afflicting utility EMAE are dragging down the economy of the island nation. The United Nations Development Program is seeking consultants to conduct feasibility studies for a 2 MW solar project and three mini hydropower plants ranging in size from 1.15-2 MW in São Tomé and Principe.

How much electricity does so Tomé & Principe have?

The facility, located on the island of Principe, has a capacity of 1 MW and is expected to be operational by 2024. Currently, renewable energies only represent 5% of the electric mix of São Tomé and Principe archipelago. This clean electricity comes mainly from the Contador hydroelectric plant with a capacity of 1.9 MW.

Where will solar power plants be installed in so Tomé?

The company will collaborate with the public utility Power and Water Company (EMAE) to install solar power plants across the country. The first phase of the program will include the installation of solar PV plants at the São Tomé international airport, as well as on the island of Príncipe, with capacities of 1.1 kW and 300 kW, respectively.
