

# Taiwan virtual power plant

Is Taiwan building a 'virtual power plant'?

State-run Taiwan Power Co (Taipower,??) is building Asia's first "virtual power plant," which would be capable of producing 15 megawatts of electricity per second,the company said yesterday. The project is expected to come online partially as early as the end of this year,Taipower said in a statement.
