What is electricity generation in Trinidad & Tobago?

Electric Power Generation In Trinidad and Tobago (T&T), electricity generation primarily uses natural gas as the fuel source. The power generation technology used are simple cycle gas turbines and combined cycle gas turbines with heat recovery steam generators.

How many independent power producers are there in Trinidad and Tobago?

The present electricity generation landscape in T&T comprises three Independent Power Producers (IPPs) providing bulk power with varying obligations and contracted capacities to Trinidad and Tobago Electricity Commission (T&TEC).

Who owns power generation in Trinidad & Tobago?

Power Generation Company of Trinidad and Tobago (POWERGEN) Ownership: In 1994, T&TEC divested its generation assets to POWERGEN, a company whose ownership structure at the time was led by T&TEC with a 51 percent shareholding, followed by Southern Electric International with 39 percent and Amoco with 10 percent.

Who owns Trinidad and Tobago Electric Company?

The Trinidad and Tobago Electric Company Limited was bought by a Canadian businessman in 1901. The company later came into being as the Trinidad and Tobago Electricity Commission (T&TEC) by virtue of the T&TEC Ordinance No. 42 of 1945.

What is the largest power plant in Trinidad & Tobago?

The 720-megawatt (MW) TGU facility is the largest combined-cycle power generation plant in the Caribbean and currently supplies approximately 50% of Trinidad & Tobago's electrical energy.

Which power stations in Trinidad and Tobago are fueled by hydrocarbons?

All power stations in Trinidad and Tobago are fueled by hydrocarbons. T&TEC was formed in 1946 after the merger of independent companies. It supplies over a million residential, municipal, commercial and industrial customers.
