Shareholder Samruk-Energy JSC is wholly owned by the Sole Shareholder, Samruk-Kazyna JSC(). “Samruk-Energy” JSC is the largest diversified electric power holding company with a primary objective of establishing a highly efficient energy supply system to support the sustainable development of all sectors in Kazakhstan.

What is the integrated annual report 2022 of Samruk-Energy JSC?

General information This Integrated Annual Report 2022 of Samruk-Energy JSC (hereinafter referred to as the Report) is the 16th paper disclosing information on financial and economic performance and operations, as well as the Company's sustainability achievements. The Report is addressed to a wide range of stakeholders.

How much electricity did Samruk-Energy JSC sell in 2022?

In 2022, Samruk-Energy JSC's power plants participated in electric capacity tenders held on the trading platform of KOREM JSC. As a result of the centralised tendering held on 19 November 2022, the power plants of Samruk-Energy JSC sold 2,734.4 MW of electricity at a price of 590,000 KZT/MW*month.

Does Samruk-Energy JSC have a corruption policy?

39 The Code of Behaviour of Samruk-Energy JSC was approved by the Samruk-Energy JSC Board of Directors' decision of 29 June 2018. In 2022, Samruk-Energy Group had not a single case of corruption. The Company's compliance service verifies reliability of third parties to eliminate corruption risks as well as risks of business reputation loss.

Currently, the company is working on projects related to "green" energy, including construction of 60 and 50 MW wind power plants in Almaty and Akmola regions, counter-regulating 40 MW Kerbulak HPP on the Ili River. "Samruk-Energy" JSC is the largest power holding company in Kazakhstan, 100% owned by "Samruk-Kazyna" SWF JSC. It was ...

On November 25, Samruk-Energy JSC (hereinafter referred to as Samruk-Energy) made a debut placement of "green" bonds by public subscription on the stock exchange of the Astana International Financial Center - Astana International Exchange in the amount of 18.4 billion tenge with a coupon rate of 11.4% per annum and a tenor of 6.5 years.

"Samruk-Energy" JSC contributed 31.8% of the Republic of Kazakhstan's overall energy production in 2022, an increase of 0.7% from 2021. Operational KPI (broken down by producers) The total amount of electricity produced in 2022 was 35,884 mln. kWh, showing

In July 2022, Samruk-Kazyna instructed Samruk-Energy JSC to set up a green company under its umbrella to manage and coordinate all Group subsidiaries that operate in the RES and hydro power sector. On 15 September 2022, the Board of Directors of the Company decided to establish Qazaq Green Power PLC public company under the jurisdiction of ...

Electricity generation by "Samruk-Energy" JSC renewable energy facilities (SPP, WPP, small hydropower plants) for 2021 amounted to 325.3 mln kWh or 7.7% of the volume of electricity generated by renewable energy facilities in the Republic of Kazakhstan, which compared to the same period in 2020 year is 2.1% lower (in 2020, electricity ...

on October 14, 2019, the meeting approved the proposal of the sole shareholder of SWF Samruk-Kazyna JSC on the re-inclusion of Tegis Munay in the single list of assets of Samruk-Energy JSC, which subsequently led to the reclassification of this company from assets held for sale back to continuing operations.

As a result of reorganization effected through the merger of "Kazakhstan holding for management of state assets "Samruk" JSC and "Sustainable development fund "Kazyna" JSC, on November 3, 2008, the Company's shareholder became "Sovereign Wealth Fund "Samruk-Kazyna" JSC, being the legal successor of "Kazakhstan holding for ...

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
